



### **Information to Competitors about Equipment Inspection**

It is mandatory that ALL sailors go through equipment inspection and that all equipment that you will use are being inspected. At the end of it, you will certify on the Measurement Form that you will not change anything without the permission of the Technical committee.

First sailors go to inspection and then to registration.

To change equipment, you will need to fill a "Request for Change of Equipment" on ROMS, then present both the damaged and replacement equipment to the Technical team for approval.

Failure to do so will result in penalties

How the inspection works:

1. Equipment Inspection will take place at the inspection place near the boats park for each group. There is an inspection area place for boys next to their boat park and one for girls next to their boat park.
2. Sailors should have already booked for an equipment inspection time slot online.  
If you have not done so, check for available time slots with the check-in desk of the Equipment Inspection Area.
3. Proceed to the equipment inspection area and join the queue\_at least 5 minutes before your booked time slot.  
Please DO NOT put your boat in the queue if you have not booked a time slot!  
You will be issued your Race Registration & Measurement Form. plus a set of stickers.
4. While in line, do not jump queue. Respect the other sailors and the measurement team - unruly and disorderly behaviours will not be accepted. Please bear in mind that the people involved in the measurement are all volunteers and will try their best to make the championship a success and that you enjoy the event.
5. All equipment must be clean and dry. Remove all items that are not required for inspection; e.g. extra mast sections, extra sails, sail and foil bags, clothing and water bottles etc. Unnecessary items lead to mistakes (e.g. measure a wrong sail, or a wrong mast) and cause delays and inconvenience to other competitors in the queue.
6. Boats shall be presented for inspection with the bottom mast, boom and all control lines rigged. The sail and the top mast shall be derigged and ready for inspection. All battens shall be removed from the sail. The tiller & tiller extension shall be removed from the rudder.

7. It is your responsibility to check that all your particulars are correct on the measurement form  
- **especially your sail numbers!**
8. At each inspection station, the inspection team shall stamp or stick an event limitation mark, and/ or initial on your equipment with your sailor number of this event.
9. When you pass your Equipment Inspection, the Technical chair will sign your Measurement Form. With this completed Form, you shall proceed to the Race Office to submit the Form and complete your registration.
